

Wynndel Irrigation District
Bylaw No. 172

A bylaw to authorize the disbursement of monies in the Renewal Reserve Fund.

WHEREAS there is an unappropriated balance in the Renewal Reserve Fund of THIRTY TWO THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FOURTEEN dollars (\$32,614.00) as at July 1, 2003 which the amount has been calculated as follows:

Balance in Fund at December 31, 2002	<u>\$32,614.00</u>
Add: Additions to fund including interest earnings for current year to date	\$ <u>0.00</u>
Deduct: total of disbursement bylaws for current year to date	\$ <u>0.00</u>
Balance in Trust Fund as at July 1, 2003	<u>\$32,614.00</u>

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to expend a portion of the monies imposed under Bylaw No.135 for the purpose of

The Trustees of the Wynndel Irrigation District ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1. The sum of THIRTY TWO THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FOURTEEN dollars (\$32,614.00) is hereby appropriated from the Renewal Reserve Fund to be expended on the installation of the 8" line from Hwy 3A to Packing Shed Road as detailed in the Mould Engineering Study.
2. The expenditure to be carried out by the monies hereby appropriated shall be more particularly specified and authorized by resolution of the Trustees.
3. Should any of the above amounts remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Reserve Fund.
4. This bylaw may be cited as the "2003 Renewal Reserve Fund Disbursement Bylaw."




