

A bylaw to authorize the disbursement of monies in the Capital Expenditure Charge Reserve Fund.

WHEREAS there is an unappropriated balance in the Capital Expenditure Charge Reserve Fund of Eleven Thousand Dollars (\$11,000.00) as at November 25, 2004 which amount has been calculated as follows:

Balance in Fund at December 31, 2003	\$0.00
Add: Additions to fund including interest earnings for current year to date	11,000.00
Deduct : Total of disbursement bylaws for current year to date	0.00
Balance in Trust Fund as at November 25, 2004	11,000.00

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to expend a portion of the monies imposed under Bylaw No. 157 for the purpose of

The trustees of the Wynndel Irrigation District ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1. The sum of Eleven Thousand Dollars (\$11,000.00) is hereby appropriated from the Capital Expenditure Charge reserve to be expended on: to augment capacity, to encourage future development and augment fire protection as recommended in the Mould Engineering Study.
2. The expenditure to be carried out by the monies hereby appropriated shall be more particularly specified and authorized by resolution of the Trustees.
3. Should any of the above amount remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Reserve Fund.
4. This bylaw may be cited as the "2004 Capital Expenditure Charge Reserve Fund disbursement Bylaw."
