A bylaw to authorize the disbursement of monies in the Capital Expenditure Charge Reserve Fund.

WHEREAS there is an unappropriated balance in the Capital Expenditure Charge Reserve Fund of SEVEN THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED AND FOUR DOLLARS (\$7,404.00) as at December 31, 2012 which amount has been calculated as follows.

Balance in Trust Fund as at April 4, 2013	<u>\$7,404.00</u>


AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to expend a portion of the monies imposed under Bylaw No 206 Wyndel Irrigation District's Capital Expenditure Charge Bylaw for the purpose of

The Trustees of the WYNDEL IRRIGATION District ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1. The sum of SEVEN THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED AND FOUR DOLLARS (\$7,404.00) is hereby appropriated from the Capital Expenditure Charge Reserve to be expended on increasing capacity of treatment with new chlorination station and chlorination system.
2. The expenditure to be carried out by the monies hereby appropriated shall be more particularly specified and authorized by resolution of the Trustees.
3. Should any of the above amounts remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Reserve Fund.
4. This bylaw may be cited as the "2013 Capital Expenditure Charge Reserve Fund Disbursement Bylaw."
